Hank Nuwer Anti-Hazing Hero Award

This prestigious award was established to recognize individuals who have spoken out against hazing, prevented it, stopped it, or in some way stood up and battled the problem. The award is named in honor of Hank Nuwer, associate professor at Franklin College, anti-hazing journalist, blogger, and the author of four books about hazing.

NHPW/NFHS High School Essay Contest

Each year, high school students throughout the country enter the essay contest by writing an original essay on hazing prevention. A specific theme is selected each year and contestants compete for cash prizes. The theme of the 2015 essay contest is *"These Hands Don't Haze"*, and is sponsored by the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS).

Hazing Prevention: It's Everyone's Responsibility, is a preventative evidence-based and interactive online course to inform students of the impact of hazing and how to prevent it. It is a one-hour course that teaches students how to recognize, prevent, and report hazing.
